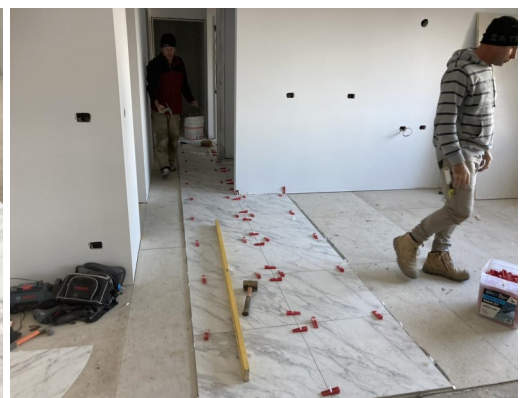

Our Latest update

August 2023

In our last newsletter we told you of our plan to fill a shipping container to send to Vanuatu late last year. After a number of delays it finally found it's way to the V2 Life Academy school in Port Vila. It was unpacked by the school and then in June this year we were able to send some much needed chairs and some tables out to Ambrym for a couple of schools to use there.



During our trip to Vanuatu in June we were also able to visit local villages and make assessments for future projects. We met with our new "family" in Ranon and visited a new school primarily using technology to teach. We also visited Megamone school that we built a few years ago now and caught up with colleagues and long time friends.



Our next project on Ambrym will be to replace a leaking roof on the girls dormitory at Ranon School.
